Dear David,

Thank you for your role in the Republican Party as representative from Ohio Township A. You have an important job of helping select the best candidates. I have a proven track record of conservative actions as a county commissioner over the past 7 years. I am asking for your endorsement vote on December 3.

I would like to provide a little about my background. Janice and I have been married 48 years. We have three children and eight grandchildren. I began my career at Procter & Gamble in Market Research in 1967 and retired after 28 years. I then had three years teaching computer class and three years as Executive Director of Clermont Transportation Connection (CTC). On the public service side, in 1968, I began volunteering on the Miamiville Fire Department. I was selected as EMS chief in 1972 and served in that capacity for 12 years. In 1987, I was selected as Fire and EMS Chief and served in that capacity for 3 years. I left the volunteer fire service to become a Miami Township Trustee in 1990. In November 2008, I was elected County Commissioner.

While you know that I currently serve as your County Commissioner, you may not be aware of the many things I have accomplished to help improve the County.

As your commissioner, I have helped to balance the county budget, even in the recession of 2008 and through the recovery. I have helped reduced waste and helped to reduce the size of county government.

At the same time I have voted to invest in public safety by expanding jail beds by 48 beds. This was critical as our jail was very overcrowded as a result of the Heroin Crisis and the theft that it fuels. The commissioners upgraded the Public Safety Radio system to a new statewide platform that allows departments to talk seamlessly between Fire, EMS, Law Enforcement, Public Works and others as needed. It also allows us to talk with our neighboring counties on mutual aid and throughout the state.

The commissioners just signed contracts for new Commuter Aided Dispatch (CAD) software that will reduce the cost for public safety dispatch and at the same time provide advanced capabilities. This will further enhance public safety.

The Clermont County Transportation Improvement District (CCTID) is investing in highway infrastructure. Improved highways bring jobs and allow our residents to get to their jobs and shopping quicker and more safely.

I am visible, available and responsive to residents of the County. I am and will continue to be a full time commissioner serving the residents of Clermont County. If not in the office or at meetings, I work from home where I have full access to email, files and phone. I am here to serve you. In addition to the charitable and civic boards on which I serve, I also attend meetings of the Central Committee and the Clermont County Tea Party to ensure I am aware of the concerns of residents.

I have worked to make Clermont County government more transparent. Our meeting agendas are published in advance on our website. Our minutes are published on the website promptly after the meetings. All of our meetings are open to the public and are televised on Time Warner Cable and on the web.
