CORCORAN ENDORSES HUMPHREY IN COMMISSIONER RACE

GOSHEN TOWNSHIP – T.J. Corcoran, who sought the Clermont County Republican Party’s endorsement for County Commissioner, announced today that he is endorsing Ed Humphrey’s candidacy and will not seek the office in the upcoming March Primary.
