Humphrey files to run for re-election

BATAVIA – Clermont County Commissioner Ed Humphrey filed petitions Tuesday (Dec. 6) to seek re-election.

Humphrey, a commissioner for three years, is running in the Republican primary to be held March 6, 2012.

Humphrey originally ran for county commissioner after allegations of wrongdoing came to light against former Commissioner Mary Walker. He has delivered on his promise to bring honest, ethical government back to the office. Humphrey also has led the Board of Commissioners in helping to draw more than 1,550 jobs to Clermont County.
